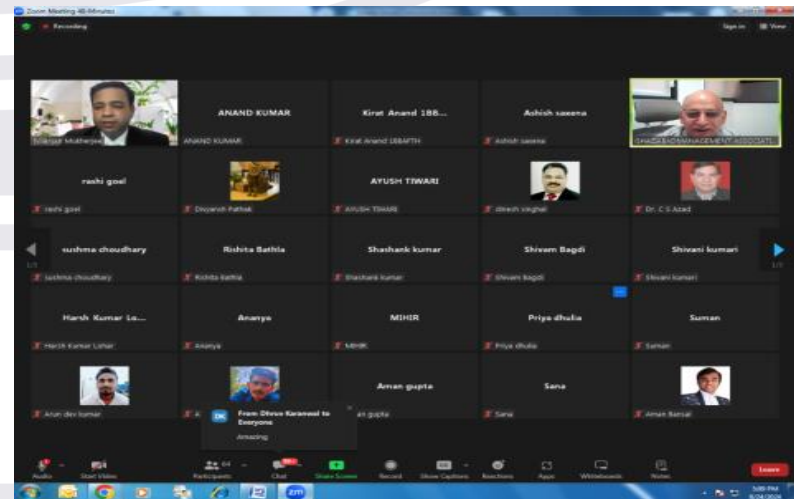
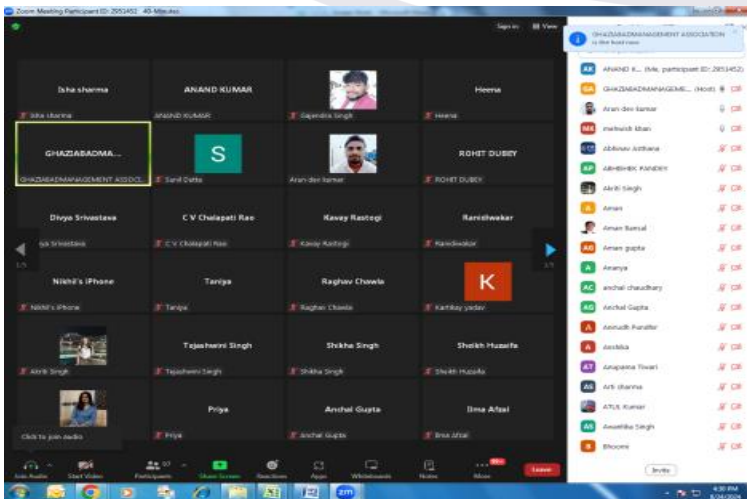


Session on “Powerful Memory: A Path to Success”

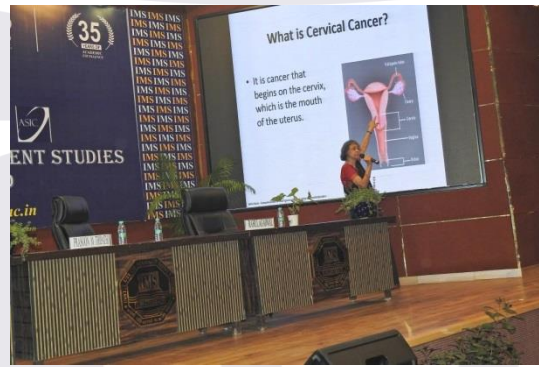


Session on “Cervical Awareness”

ACTIVITY # 6

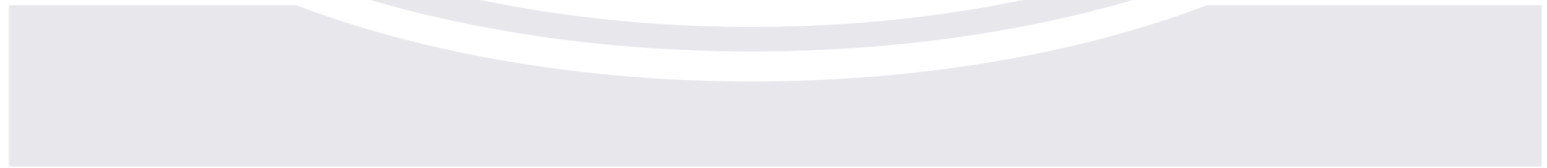
