CA Pankaj Jain touched upon many new aspects such as Carbon emission affect on export cost, RoTDEP, MOOWR (Mfg other operation in warehouse operation), Global Capability Centers which will increase employability. ACTIVITY # 4

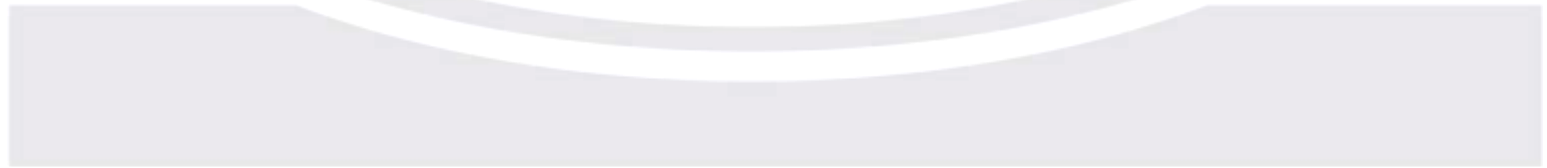
