

Ghaziabad Management Association had organized an online session on Artificial Intelligence: Driving into Al: An Industry friendly introduction to Artificial intelligence. The speaker was Mr. Anshu Bhartiya, risk Analyst, IBM Global Business services. He started with a basic explanation of Algorithm and Al in layman's definition, its application and pitfalls. The need for Al is in improved efficiency, personalization, better decision making, and exploration of new frontiers like Chandrayan. Al helps in all functions, be it production, finance, HR, Cyber security Data Analytics, and communication. Al Drawbacks and issues: were also explained. Small businesses can adopt Al in a strategic and manageable way, leveraging technology to enhance their operations and stay competitive in the market. It is essential for SMEs to start small, focusing on specific use cases that align with their business goals and resources, investing in employee training to build Al capabilities within the organization is crucial. It is often advisable to begin with a single, well defined project before expanding to other areas. This approach allows for a more manageable implementation process and provides the opportunity to learn and adapt to the use of Al technologies in the business context. Al won't replace people, but people who use Al will replace people. More than 100 participants logged in for a useful session as an introduction to Al.
